THE HARDIN BOY'S JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP JUNE 9 & 10, 2010 BOGEY HILLS COUNTRY CLUB

ELIGIBILITY: Entrant must be a male amateur member of a Member Club of the St. Louis District Golf Association. A player may play above his age group, but only in one division. Age divisions are as follows:

- JUNIORS: Must not reach age 18 by 6/9/10
- INTERMEDIATE: Must not reach age 16 by 6/9/10
- JUVENILES: Must not reach age 14 by 6/9/10
- MIDGETS: Must not reach age 12 by 6/9/10

This is a National Junior Golf Scoreboard (NJGS) Ranked event.

SCHEDULE: The age divisions of Juniors, Intermediate and Juveniles will be 36 holes at stroke play; Midgets will be 18 holes (9 holes each day) at stroke play.

Lowest score for 36 Holes will be Champion and will have custody of the Hord W. Hardin & Hord Hardin III Trophy for one year. Any tie(s) for the overall champion will be decided immediately by a sudden death hole-by-hole playoff.

The lowest 2 scores for 36 holes (18-hole players) will be the STLDGA Junior Team Champions.

RULES OF GOLF: Play will be governed by the United States Golf Association Rules of Golf.

REGISTRATION : All players must be ready to play at their appropriate starting point and published starting time.

ENTRIES: Entrants shall apply on the attached form. \$50.00 entry fee per person shall be paid by every applicant. Entry Application and fees must reach the Association's Office at the address listed on the entry form by **4:00 p.m., May 27, 2010. No Refunds after the deadline.**

CADDIES: A player may provide his own caddie at any time during the Championship, provided the caddie is not participating in the Championship or a player may carry his own clubs.

PARENTS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO CADDIE OR COACH THEIR CHILD OR CHILDREN.

GOLF BALLS; EQUIPMENT: Only brands of golf balls on the most current USGA Conforming Ball List may be used. The Optional Condition, as set forth in Appendix I of USGA Rules of Golf, which places a limitation on golf balls used during a round (One-Ball Rule), is **NOT** in effect. All clubs utilized during the Championship must be conforming under USGA Rules. (See Appendix II, USGA Rules of Golf.)

PERSONAL APPEARANCE: During all phases of the Championship, Competitors must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. No novelty t-shirts, gym shorts, cut-offs and/or jeans.
